INTERNAL RULES

I. I: Terms and conditions

1°) Admission

To come in, to settle down and to stay in the camping site of St.Germain du Bois, you have to be allowed to enter by one the responsible persons. You must respect the rules of behavior and apply the internal rules.

By staying on the campsite of St. Germain you accept and respect the present Terms and Conditions.

2°) Police formalities

Each person remaining even only one night on the Campsite of St. Germain has to show its identity card or passport and fill in the forms required by the police. Minors need to show a parental consent, written and signed by their parents.

3°) Installation

The setting up of the tent and the installing of the caravan have to take place at the location shown by the responsible or his assistant.

4°) Office

Opening hours:

May-June-September:

Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday: 8.00 am-11.00 am and 2.00 pm – 4.00 pm

On Tuesday: 2.00 pm- 4.00 pm

On Saturday : 8.00 am - 12.00 am, and 2.00 pm - 6.00 pm

Closed on Sunday

July-August:

Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday: 8.00 am-11.00 am and 3.30 pm - 7.00 pm

On Tuesday: 3.30 pm- 7.00 pm

On Saturday : 8.00 am - 12.00 am, and 3.00 pm - 7.00 pm

Closed on Sunday

In this office you will find all information about services on the campsite, about shops in the village, sport equipments, tourist attractions and several other useful addresses.

You will find a post box for your complaints and your proposals for improvement. Please remember, only signed and dated requests will be taken into account.

5°) Rates

The rates have to be paid at the reception office. The amount depends on the number of nights and the accommodation you chose. The rates are displayed at the entry and in the office.

Users may inform the office about their departure the day before leaving.

If you have the intention to leave before the opening hours of the office you must settle your stay the evening before leaving

6°) Noise and silence

Users should avoid any noises that could trouble other users and neighbors.

Radios, TV and other sound machines should be adjusted accordingly. Closing of car doors and trunks should be as discreet as possible.

No dogs or other pets are allowed to be free on the campsite. If you leave the campsite, don't leave your pet even in a closed caravan. You should know that you (the owner of your pet) are at every moment responsible of your animal.

SILENCE IS REQUIRED FROM 11 PM TO 7.00 AM

7°) Guests/visitors

Users may receive guests one the responsible authorized their coming. However, the user is responsible of his guests and their behavior.

You may welcome your guests at the entrance. If your guests use the equipments of the campsite, the responsible may charge their using. (see the rates at the entry and in the office).

Guests are not allowed to enter with their car in the campsite, they park outside.

8°) Traffic and parking of vehicles

Within the confines of the campsite, speed limit is 10 km/h.

No traffic between 11.00 pm and 7.00 am

Only users' cars are allowed to drive in the campsite. Don't park on the pitches, and do not park on the paths, too. You mustn't hinder future campers / users.

9°) Maintenance and appearance of the facilities

Users mustn't do anything to damage property, hygiene and appearance of the campsite, specially the sanitary facilities.

Don't dispose waste water on the floor and in the gutters.

Caravan users: it is compulsory to use the special installation for your waste water!

All garbage, waste and papers needs to be collected in the different dustbins.

Dishwashing has to be done in the sinks.

One washing machine is at your disposal. You may change € against washing chips at the office.(the responsible will tell you the schedule) Any damage will be charged to the users account. Near the washing machine you will find clothes-lines, otherwise you may dry your laundry near your pitch (until 10.00 am and if you don't disturb your neighbors). Don't hang clothes in the trees.

You must respect the plantations and flower decorations. Don't hammer a nail in any tree, don't cut any branches, and don't make any plantation.

Any damage of nature, fences, to the site or the equipment will be charged. Leave you pitch as you have found it.

10°) <u>Sécurity</u>

a – Fire

Open fires are prohibited. All stoves should be maintained and never used if it seems dangerous (windy weather, thunderstorms)

In case of fire, warn the responsible, fire extinguishers are available.

A First aid kit is available at the office.

b-Theft

All items deposited at the office are under the responsibility of the campsite and the responsible persons try to supervise the campsite.

However, users are responsible of their own installation and have to mention any suspicious looking person. Normal precautions are required for saving your goods.

11°) Games

No violent or loud games should be organized near the pitches.

The meeting room is not a playground.

Parents must keep an eye on their children.

12°) Garage mort

There mustn't be anything left on your pitch once you leave. If you want to deposit some items, ask at the office, the responsible will inform you about the rates.

13°) Display

These terms and conditions are displayed at the entry and in the office of the campsite. You may get one on request.

14°) Offenses against these terms and conditions

Users not respecting theses terms and conditions and disturbing by their behavior other guests, might be admonished (orally or by writing) to stop their troubles by the responsible of the campsite.

In case of serious or repeated offense to these terms and conditions, the responsible may withdraw the contract.

In case of criminal offense, the responsible may call the police department
